

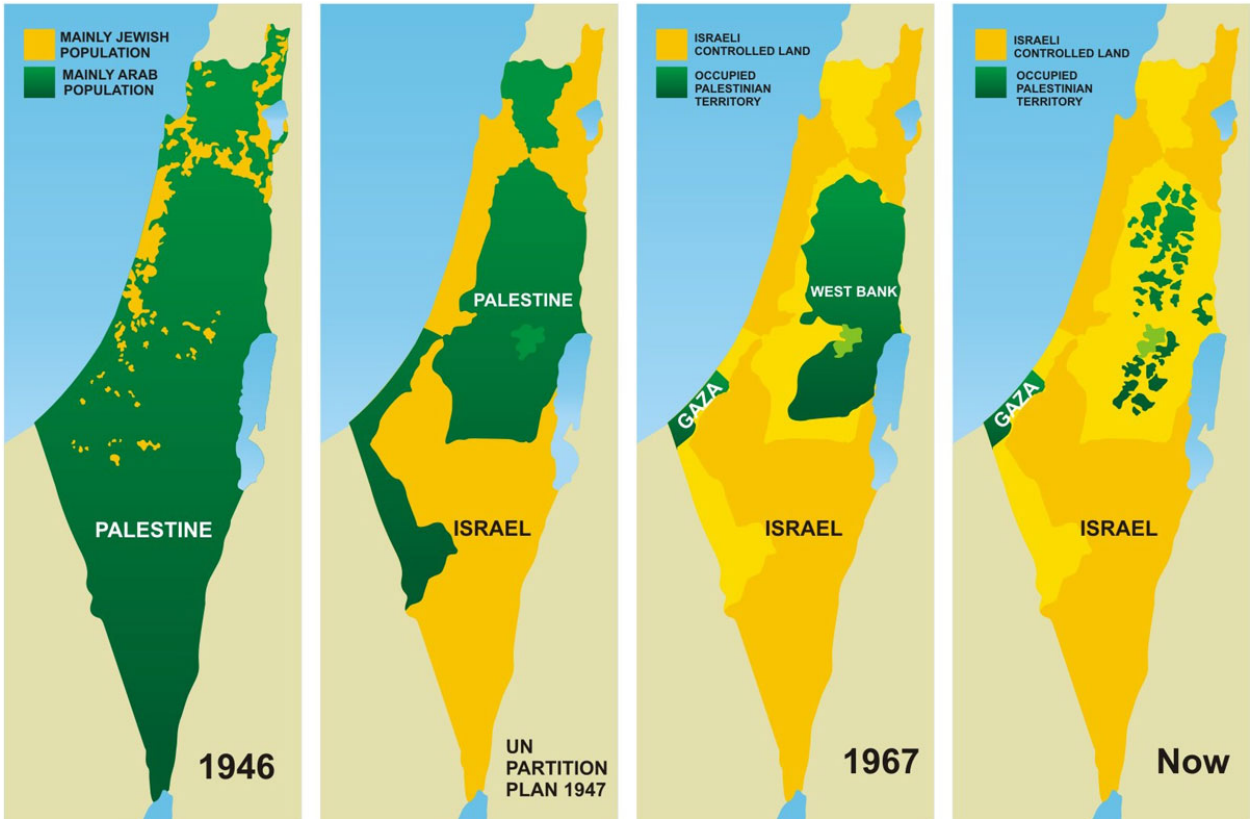

On 1948 | Ilan Pappé | Part I | 2018 interview, Transliminal, 9/1/18, an hour and 4 minutes.

"What happened to the Palestinians when Israel declared its independence in 1948? Was it ethnic cleansing? Chaos? Legitimate Jewish self-defense?"

Prof. Ilan Pappé is perhaps the most contentious Israeli historian of this question. Decidedly left-wing in his outlook, Pappé is both an historian, and a social activist. He's perhaps most famous for his book "The Ethnic Cleansing of Palestine," in which he lays out a case that the war for the creation of Israel in 1948 is best understood as an ethnic cleansing of the native Palestinian population by primarily European Jews.

Unsurprisingly, Pappé's scholarship is widely derided in Israel. Yet his work is often celebrated by many pro-Palestinian activists in the Middle East and abroad. Pappé currently teaches history at the University of Exeter, in the UK. This is part one of my two part interview with Pappé last summer, in Haifa."

My comments:

Pappé completely spills the beans, reveals how even the allegedly socialist and Soviet-friendly Mapam party, Mifleget Ha'Poalim Ha;Meuhedet, 'United Workers Party,' which publicly called for a binational state, participated in the ethnic cleansing with relish. He also discusses some other aspects, such as how Iraq's and Morocco's Jews were scared into leaving and moving to Israel in 1949-early '50s via a false flag "terrorism" campaign carried out by Moddad agents, several of whom subsequently stepped forward to admit this. Jews from Arab nations have long been discriminated against in Israel, this was particularly bad when I was growing up there in the '50s.

My comments:

HIGHLY RECOMMENDED. *The ongoing expansion of the settlements basically contradict any Israeli claims to being a democratic state with peaceful intents. Change is impossible as long as the notion of "Chosen People" persists as the dominant ideology in Israel. Dissidents are marginalized out of existence in Israel, and anyone opposing the colonialism and the Apartheid regime leaves, so change is unlikely from within.*

He talked a bunch about the daily reality of life in the Occupied Territories under Apartheid. He has come to reject the "Two States Solution" and favors "One nation, one person = one vote." I myself don't think any nation state is "viable," as all nation states are instruments of coercion against working people, and are current imposing the Great Reset/4IR. A non-apartheid Israel would be in the very immediate beneficial for the victims of apartheid policies, but would only be added to the general ranks of recipients of state oppression on behalf of capital.

My comments:

HIGHLY RECOMMENDED. She detailed ***the day to day experience, including separate roads for Israeli settlers and Arabs, the first ones far superior, and different water rights, settlers getting extreme preference in allocation.*** Interviews with Israelis who think that all Arabs should be killed.
